Telephone Contacts:

When travelling so far from home, loved ones might need to contact you in the event of an emergency, or just to see if everything is going well.

From 7:00 a.m. to midnight, messages can be left with the person on duty at the Front Desk in the Campus Residence (X 27222). The message will then be hand delivered to the individual's room.

Between midnight and 7:00 a.m., in case of an emergency, it would be possible to reach a participant by calling the University Switchboard 1(905) 525-9140 asking for 'Security'.
