<b>2</b>	<b>Was prognostic balance maintained as the study progressed?</b>	
2a	Were patients, caregivers, collectors of outcome data, adjudicators of outcomes, and data analysts aware of group allocation?	
<b>3</b>	<b>Were groups prognostically balanced at the study's conclusion?</b>	
3a	Was follow-up complete?	

3b	Was the trial stopped early for benefit?	
3c	Were patients analyzed in the groups to which they were randomized?
