How serious is the risk of bias?

Were outcome criteria objective and unbiased?	
What are the results?	
How likely are the outcomes over time?	
How precise are the estimates of likelihood?	
How can I apply the results to patient care?	
Were the study patients and their management similar to those in my practice?	
Was the follow-up sufficiently long?	
Can I use the results in the management patients in my practice?
